

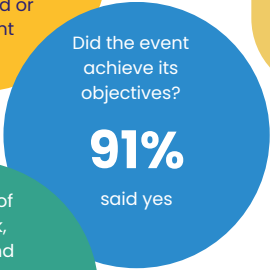
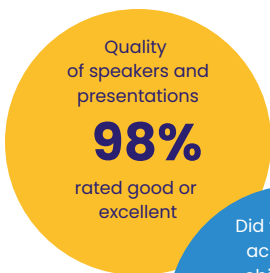


Introduction to Migration Training
