Connecting Opportunities (CO) works with new migrants to develop their skills and opportunities to find work and be part of the local community. Ten organisations that specialise in working with migrants offer tailored support across West Yorkshire and parts of North Yorkshire. We are funded by the European Social Fund and the National Lottery Community Fund.

We welcome new migrants who:

- ✔ are aged 15 and above
- ✔ live in the project area (see map)
- ✔ have permission to work in the UK but are not in work
- ✔ have arrived into the UK within the last 10 years and who do not have British Citizenship.



Services include:

-  Keyworker support
-  Employment support
-  ESOL/English language support
-  Mental health and wellbeing support
-  Mentoring and befriending
-  Services offered via phone, Skype, Zoom, etc.
